Bylaws Amendment Specification of Proxy Process

In the Bylaws, the process for finding a proxy is not clearly outlined. For example, delegates are currently encouraged in meetings to find proxies from their own college, but this is not currently outlined in the Bylaws. The language about finding a proxy ("delegates may appoint a proxy") also does not represent the importance of finding a proxy for assembly meetings.

Recommended Course of Action:

It is proposed that the GPSA adopt the following amendment to the GPSA Bylaws:

ARTICLE I – ASSEMBLY OF DELGATES

G. Delegates may are strongly encouraged to appoint a proxy in the event of their absence. Delegate proxies shall be presented to the Speaker of the Assembly before the start of the applicable meeting. No person shall serve as a proxy for two (2) delegates during the same meeting. No delegate may serve as a proxy for another delegate. No delegate who has been removed from their position within the last two (2) Assembly terms may serve as a proxy. Delegates are encouraged to find a proxy from their own academic college or constituency, though this is not required. The Faculty Senator that is elected by the graduate student body

is eligible to be a proxy, as they do not have voting privileges in the GPSA.
