1 Nature of the Situation:

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GPSA's Professional Development Committee gives voice to the interests and needs of graduate and professional students by promoting professional and scholarly activity. The Graduate Writing Boot Camp is designed to support graduate and professional students in meeting their writing goals by providing a quiet and supportive writing environment. Previously the Assembly passed Bill 70-10 to fund lunch for 20 participants; however, this event has been more successful than anticipated. Therefore, we now propose Bill 70-18 to increase the number of slots from 20 participants to 60 per weekly session. Additionally, since many restaurants have reduced hours due to COVID-19, in this bill, we are expanding the list of restaurants that GWBC is catering from.

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Similar to the first session, which is currently ongoing, the second session will last 6 weeks.
