**Bylaws Amendment
Resignation Process**

Nature of the Situation:

The GPSA Assembly of Delegates does not have a formal resignation process listed in the governing documents. Many folks that need to resign have asked how to do so, and therefore it would be helpful for a process to be specified.

Recommended Course of Action:

It is proposed that the GPSA adopt the following amendment to the GPSA Bylaws:

ARTICLE I – ASSEMBLY OF DELGATES

L. In order to resign, a member of the GPSA should notify the President in addition to the Speaker, Chief Justice, or the Graduate Council Student Caucus Chair for assembly delegates, judiciary members and Graduate Council Student Caucus members, respectively. The resignation should be timely, in writing, and specify when the member is resigning. Resignations should be announced at the next assembly meeting.
