4 **Recommended Course of Action:**

5 The Graduate and Professional Student Association authorizes the programming  
6 committee to purchase the following items for the tie dye class: 50 white GPSA t-shirts,  
7 tie dye kits, disposable gloves, rubber bands, zip lock bags, and a tarp. To compensate  
8 David for his time and expertise he will receive \$50/hour for a 90-minute class and 30  
9 minutes of preparation to total \$100.
