Nature of the Situation:

The Diversity Banquet is an annual event put on by the Student Bar Association's Law & Equity Committee. - A budget breakdown of event costs must be submitted with this form
- The event must be open to all students (undergraduate, graduate, professional)
- The GPSA will only fund specific line items (i.e. food, room rentals, speaker fees, etc.);
 preference will be given to payments made directly by the GPSA to vendors via invoice, and
 transfers to a student organization account or reimbursements to an individual for payments
 made are strongly discouraged
- Because the GPSA's funding comes from the University Park Student Fee Board, at most up to 90% of the event cost can be funded from the GPSA for co-sponsorships
